The Indian higher education system is on the brink of great transformations to cope with global competence. This system is one of the third largest higher educational systems in the world, comprising 864 universities and 40,026 colleges, 11,669 stand alone institutions. Maintaining quality in this system is a matter of long-term initiative. To reach this long-term goal, Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) was established in Kakaraparti Bhavanarayana College in 2005. The prime responsibility of IQAC is to initiate, plan and supervise various activities that are necessary to increase the quality of the education imparted in the college.
