## Report

The Department of Botany has organized a “Field Trip to GSR Nursery” (Vegetable, Fruit and Flower Gardens), Undavalli with III B.Sc. (CBZ) students. In this regard The Students have collected different species of plants showing diversified vegetation flower. The Students have acquired practical knowledge about root, stem and flower inflorescence and modification types.

The plants grown in Undavalli are Banana, Pomagranate, Moringa, Citrus, Annona, Musambi, Vegetable such as Coccinia, Colochasia, Onion, Leafy vegetable Coriander, Mint, Spinach, Amaranthus. The plants studies made by the students are

1. Datura, 2. Euphorbia, 3. Argemon Mexicana, 4. Indigofera, 5. Achyranthus aspera, 6. Pistia, 7. Eichornia, 8. Jatropha, 9. Tridax, 10. Butea etc. The students got interaction with the farmers and got information about the vegetation type, growing pattern, harvesting methods, soil ploughing and other information regarding the vegetation. They also visited GSR Nursery and got good information about the nursery types and the plants growing in the nursery like Tomato, Pappaya, Cherry, Santhemmmum, colochasia, Chillies and Brinjal which were cultivated in the nursery and supplied to the farmers. The students are very happy in getting both practical and theory knowledge through this field trip.
