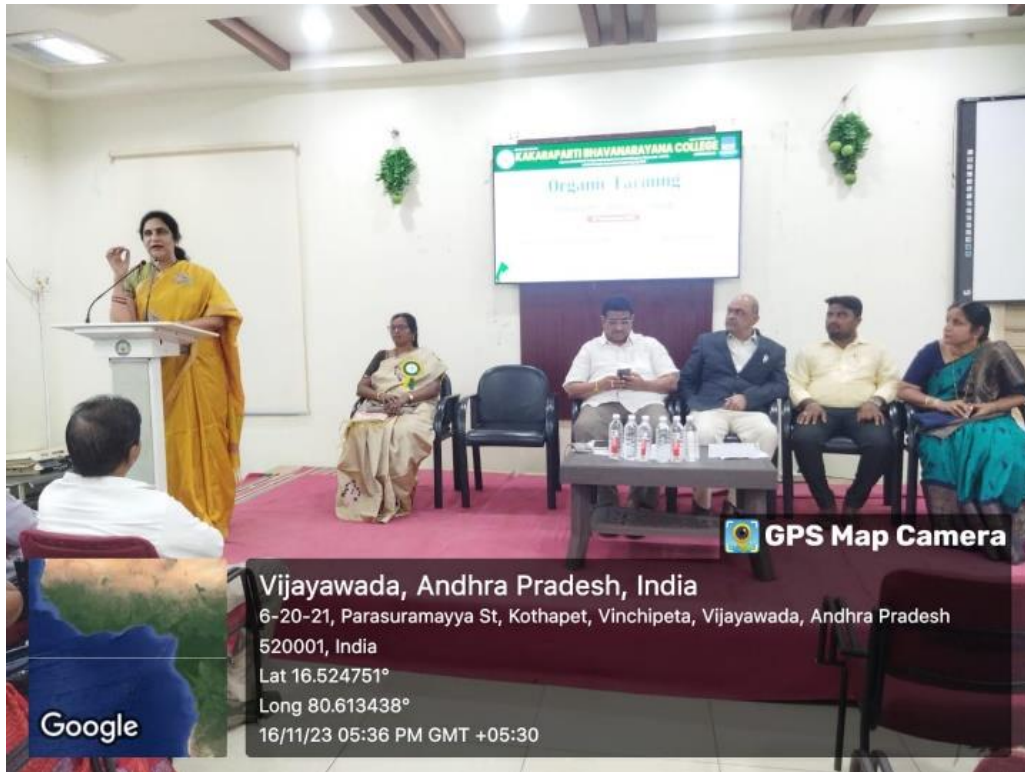
Objectives:

In the workshop, Koneru Garu emphasized the pressing need for a shift towards organic farming in light of the challenges posed by a growing global population. Acknowledging the limitations of the 'Green Revolution' with its reliance on high-input agrochemicals, she stressed the importance of moving towards a more sustainable agricultural approach.

Koneru Garu highlighted the key characteristics of organic farming, including the preservation of soil fertility through organic matter maintenance and the promotion of soil biological activity. She underscored the use of relatively insoluble nutrient sources activated by soil microorganisms. The speaker emphasized organic farming's reliance on natural methods for weed, disease, and pest control, such as crop rotations, natural predators, and organic manuring.

Furthermore, Koneru Garu drew attention to the broader environmental impact of farming practices, emphasizing the need for careful consideration and conservation efforts. In her address, she positioned organic farming as a holistic approach that not only addresses immediate agricultural challenges but also ensures a sustainable coexistence with the environment.
