REPORT

The 17 (A) Bn, Vijayawada KBNC National Cadet Corps celebrated “Kargil Vijay Diwas” on 26th July, 2018. The Chief Guest for this Programme is Lt. Col. P. Madhu Sudhana Rao, Administrative Officer, 17 (A), Bn, Vijayawada.

He addressed the students about Kargil Vijay Diwas named after the success of Operation Vijay. On this day, 26 July 1999, India successfully took command of the high outposts which had been lost to Pakistani intruders. The Kargil war was fought for more than 60 days, ended on 26 July and resulted in the loss of life on both the sides. The war ended with India regaining control of all the occupied territory, and hence establishing status quo ante bellum.

Sri D. Srinivasa Rao, Co-ordinator, Jammu Kashmir Study Centre addressed the students that Kargil Vijay Diwas is celebrated on 26 July every year in honour of the Kargil War's Heroes.
