

RALLY & AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON AIDS ON 1st DECEMBER, 2017.

In view of World Aids Day on 1st December 2017, Red Ribbon Club, NSS and NCC units of KBN College together organised a program on AIDS awareness. The resource person for the program is Retd. Superintendent of Government Hospital, Vijayawada and former Principal of Siddhartha Medical College Sri.Dr. Paladugu Rambabu. He reminded the students and staff that the disease was recognised in 1980's. He gave awareness that the symptoms of the disease will be expressed to outside in five to twenty years. He told at present the intensity of the disease decreased because of the awareness created by the Government and Social Service organisations. He told that of the total patients in India 10% are in Andhra Pradesh. Hence the public should take care during blood transfusion and organ transplantation. He concluded by informing the students that Good Behaviour is the only vaccine for AIDS. College Principal DR. V. Narayana Rao suggested that more awareness programs and discussions should be carried on in this aspect.
